Welcome to U3A Southport 2023. We hope you all had a joyful and relaxing holiday break and are looking forward to the start of Semester 1 on the 6<sup>th</sup> February.

The response to our new website has been very positive with people commenting that it is clearer, easier to read and very user friendly. The addition of online registration and class enrolment to the website has been very well accepted and has made the process much easier for both members and office staff. If you are unable to access the internet, or do not feel comfortable with the online process, our helpful front office staff are there to process your membership and class enrolments manually.

Every year there are rumblings about the cost of our membership and at first glance, it is much higher than other U3A's. For example, to join U3A Brisbane the membership fee is only \$45, but you then pay for each class with the majority costing around \$50. So that equates to \$95 for one class only. At U3A Southport, renewing members pay \$80. If you were to do 5 classes per week, the cost per class is a mere 40 cents – approximately the cost of one egg! You cannot argue with the value for money.

U3A Southport is a totally volunteer organisation – we are people-powered – and we are always in need of volunteers in a variety of capacities to keep the wheels running smoothly. If you feel you could contribute in any way to help make OUR U3A bigger, better and brighter, we would love to hear from you.

New year, new classes and new people to meet – the start of Semester 1 is an exciting time. While there are a number of new classes already on the list, we are still sourcing more to offer an even greater variety of topics for you to enjoy. Watch this space.

## What is Streaming?

Streaming is an easy way to watch movies and TV shows via the internet. It allows users to stream video from any device with a connection, including your computer and smartphone, meaning you can tune in whether you're at home or travelling!

In addition to instantly watching new releases, many streaming services also offer full seasons of popular television shows (including ones that are no longer airing). However, you'll need a paid subscription plan in order for these features to be available for viewing on your device of choice.

## **How Does it Compare?**

With streaming services, you can watch the movies and TV shows you want, when you want. You don't have to wait for your favourite show to come on or wait until the cable company is making its rounds in order to get a show. With streaming services, it's available immediately at any time of day. You also don't need an expensive cable package or satellite dish; just pick up a subscription plan with your chosen service and start enjoying it!

You also won't be limited by the number of devices that stream content; these days it's common for people to own multiple devices capable of streaming video content (smartphones/tablets/laptops/desktops). If one device is not enough for you, then simply purchase another subscription plan from another provider and enjoy unlimited access across all your devices!

And finally: no more commercials! While traditional free-to-air television channels are constantly interrupting programs with commercials, streaming services let you watch from start to finish, uninterrupted.

  original programming, as well as movies and TV shows from other providers, including Netflix
  and HBO.
- Acorn TV Acorn TV offers unique programming you won't find anywhere else. It's an
  independent British channel that specializes in British television programs from the past 40 years
  (including many previously unavailable shows).
- **9Now** 9Now is a free-to-air catch up TV service, available through 9Now.com.au and the 9Now app. With 9Now you can watch your favourite shows whenever you want, wherever you are and on the device of your choice.
- Stan Stan launched back in 2015 as Australia's first subscription video-on-demand service
  dedicated exclusively to TV shows from around the world (including Australia). It has since
  grown into one of the most popular platforms for watching TV shows online thanks to its highquality content.
- Kayo With Kayo, you can watch all the action from the Premier League, Super Rugby and more. You'll never miss a game with Kayo's live and on-demand sport coverage.
