



Queensland Pensioners Rail Entitlements & Discounts

Take the train on a coastal getaway to Queensland's favourite coastal cities, from the Fraser Coast and Southern Great Barrier Reef to the Whitsundays, Townsville and Cairns.

Trek west for a Queensland outback experience in Emerald, Barcaldine, Longreach, Roma, Charleville, Charters Towers or Mount Isa.

Did you know that the following Concession Card holders are eligible to four (4) rail entitlements each calendar year to travel long-distance across Queensland.

- Queensland Pensioner Card
- Australian Government DVA Health Card endorsed as WAR WIDOW/WIDOWER (Queensland residents only)
- Spouse/partner of a Totally and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) or Extreme Disability Adjustment (EDA) Veteran travel pass holder with a confirmation letter stating they are a Queensland resident.

A Carer, when accompanying a customer who requires assistance using rail entitlements, can travel free of charge on long-distance services.

Rail entitlements can be for rail travel and RailBus Connections.

Examples of the fares when using entitlements.

- Economy Seat: One-way journey using one entitlement, the cost is \$25 per person (non-refundable administration fee)
- Business Seat: One-way journey using two entitlements, the cost is \$50 per person (non-refundable administration fee)

 RailBed and Sleeper: One-way journey using two entitlements for each trip. The cost varies depending on the journey with a cost of an administration fee and mandatory berth and meal charges.

Fare examples:

Tilt Train

Total cost – one-way per person		
Economy Seat	One (1) entitlement	\$25.00*
Business Seat	Two (2) entitlements	\$50.00*

To start using your entitlements, you must register your details before booking online for the first time. Please contact Queensland Rail to set up your profile and validate your concession card details by either:

- Phoning 1800 872 467
- Presenting your concession card at a Travel Centre, Ticketing Station or a rail accredited Travel Agent
- Emailing reservations@qr.com.au with a scanned or photographed copy of the concession card (front and back) with your name clearly visible.
