# 3G NETWORK IS SHUTTING DOWN - How Will it Affect You?

WILL YOUR MOBILE PHONE OR MEDIC ALERT BE AFFECTED WHEN TELSTRA, OPTUS AND VODAFONE SHUT

The change will affect more than mobile phones (although they are the most common devices which will be impacted). Medical-alert technology, baby monitors, EFTPOS machines and farming equipment all use the 3G network. A lot of devices like medical equipment will need to be upgraded.

**DOWN THEIR 3G NETWORKS?** 

One provider said it had sent more than 4,000 notices to customers who were using *medical alert devices* which will stop working when the network is abandoned.



You can check if your device depends on 3G with the manufacturer, and if it does, they should be able to tell you how you can stay connected.

Telcos will begin shutting down their 3G networks from December 15, 2023. Vodafone will be the first network to disconnect, followed by Telstra on June 30, 2024 and finally Optus network in September 2024. The 3G network is being scrapped Australia wide; so regardless of where you live, you will lose your connection.

Telstra has warned devices that cannot access the 4G network will NOT be able to call triple-0. If another provider in the area is still operating a 3G network calls may connect but there is no quarantee.

#### COST OF LIVING REBATE FOR HOUSEHOLDS

Queenslanders will pay less for electricity in 2023–24 through the Cost-of-Living Rebate, with households receiving one of the following:

- \$700 Cost of Living Rebate on electricity bills for vulnerable households, plus a further \$372 under the Queensland Electricity Rebate Scheme, bringing total rebates for Queenslanders doing it toughest to \$1,072
- \$550 Cost of Living Rebate on electricity bills for all other Queensland households.

For most households, the rebate will be credited to electricity bills on a quarterly basis commencing from 1 July 2023. For more information see <u>Cost of Living Rebate for Households | Community support | Queensland Government (www.qld.gov.au)</u>

#### SEPTEMBER 2023 AGE PENSION INCREASES

The Federal Government have confirmed the *new payment rates from 20 September 2023* for recipients of the Age Pension, Disability Support Pension, and Carer Payments. **Singles can expect an increase of \$32.70 a fortnight and couples can expect an increase of \$24.70 a fortnight**.
